

Community Gynaecology Procurement Project Patient Representative Information Pack

Women in Barnet have access to a gynaecology service which is provided in a community setting. This means that, depending on the treatment required, patients do not have to go to the main hospitals for their appointments. The contract for this service is ending on 31 December 2015 and NHS Barnet Clinical Commissioning Group is looking to re-procure a community gynaecology service to make sure that women have access to a high quality and effective service.

In order to do this, we need local women to join our project team so that we can ensure that the service will meet needs of those who will use it.

We will be asking service providers to submit a proposal for a service outlining what they can offer, the benefits to local woman and how this will improve the service already in place.

What you will need to do

You will work with members of the Procurement Project Team to evaluate the proposals submitted by the providers. The final scoring will be done online so access to a computer is vital.

You will be required to attend meetings, once a month, on a Thursday morning for around an hour over the period May – September.

Will you be reimbursed for any travel/parking costs?

Yes, all reasonable expenses will be reimbursed to you.

Training

You will receive full training to enable you to effectively evaluate the proposals.
